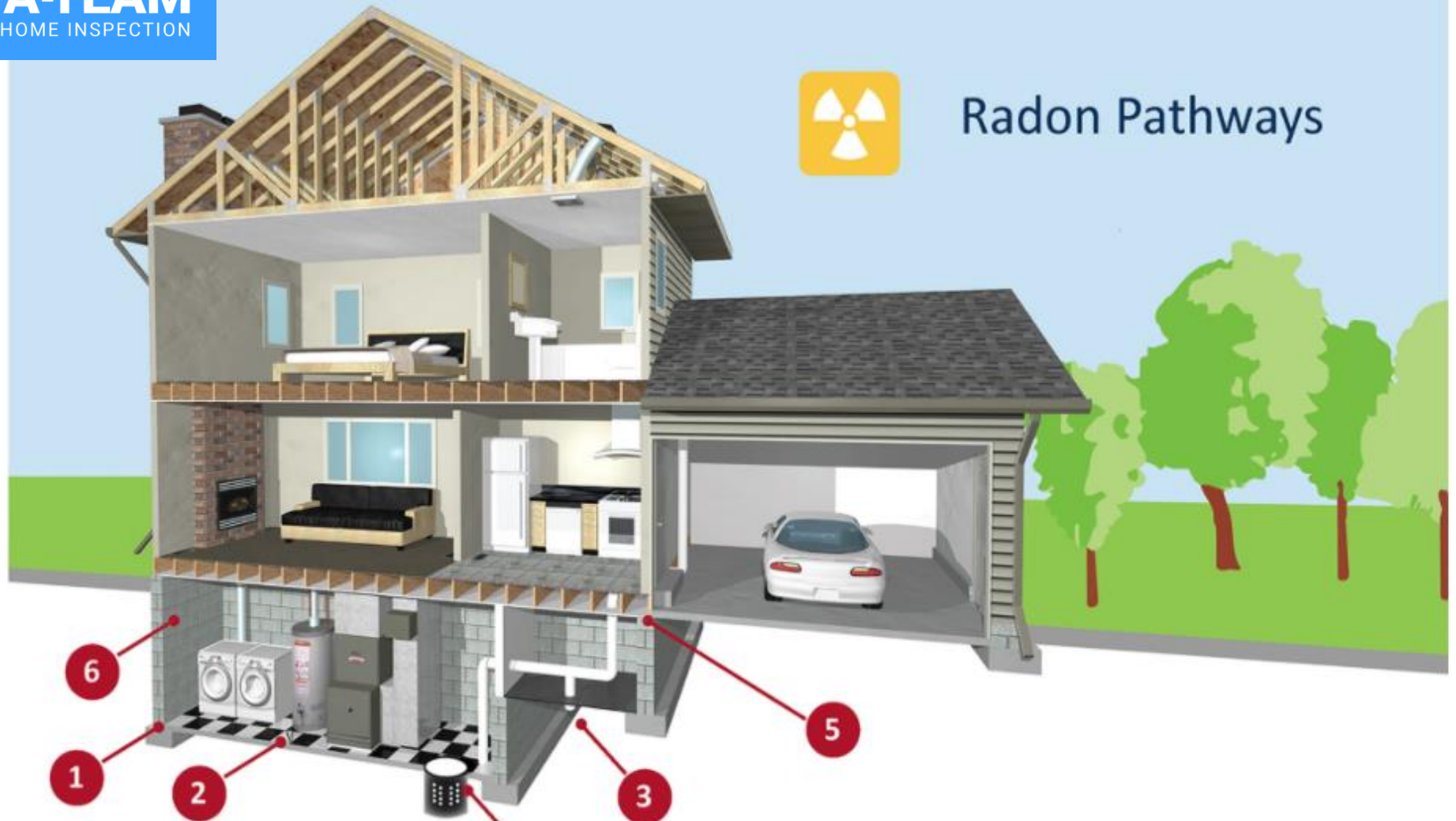




Radon Pathways



- 1 Floor – wall joints
- 2 Pores and cracks in concrete blocks or slabs
- 3 Exposed soil, such as in a crawl space

- 4 Sump basket
- 5 Open tops of block walls
- 6 Mortar joints
